### RE: NEW DATES FOR 2010 AEAA ANNUAL CONFERENCE

This is to inform you that the 2010 Annual AEAA Conference will now be held from **3rd to 8th October 2010** in Abuja, Nigeria, and **not in June 2010** as earlier communicated.

The change has been necessitated by the fact that in June, some Primary Members will be engaged in the administration of their national examinations. Also owing to the fact that prospective presenters are busy people, the remaining time between now and June 2010 is too short a period to research and present quality papers during the conference. Further, the International Association for Educational Assessment (IAEA) will be holding its annual conference in Thailand from **23rd to 27th August 2010** meaning that if AEAA Conference were to be held in the same month, it will be too close and many interested Primary Members will not be able to attend/participate.

In view of these developments, I am happy to inform you that the Local Organising Committee (LOC) in Nigeria has deliberated on the matter and re-scheduled the conference to October **3rd to 8th 2010 (see attachment)**.
