► Adwa 00Km and Ethnographic Museum

The Adwa 00 Km Museum in central Addis Ababa focuses on human history, art and culture, particularly documenting the Battle of Adwa and its comprehensive collection of items. It stands as one of the city's most captivating sights.



The Ethnological Museum, also in Addis Ababa, is dedicated to ethnology and culture, showcasing anthropological, musicological, and cultural artifacts. It is the first university museum in Ethiopia.

► National Museum and Entoto Park

The National Museum of Ethiopia, situated in Addis Ababa near the University's Graduate school, is a key repository of the country's cultural, historical, and archeological artifacts. It is renowned for its paleoanthropological exhibits, including the famous early hominid fossil "Lucy". Entoto Park, located on Mount Entoto to the North of Addis Ababa, features attractions like the Maya View Point, the Covid-19 Memorial Monument, and Green Gold, a spot for enjoying coffee and traditional coffee ceremonies.
