- 1.2 It was established in the year 1982 by Examination and Assessment Boards from **six (6)** member states of **Kenya**, Uganda, Tanzania, Botswana, Lesotho and Malawi. The Association started as a subregional conference for Heads of institutions responsible for educational assessment in the Eastern and Southern Africa which has since been spread to the rest of the continent.
- 1.3 The vision of the Association for Educational Assessment in Africa (AEAA) is "Harmonization of Education Assessment on the African continent".
- 1.4 AEAA is an affiliate member to the International Association for Educational Assessment (IAEA). The membership of IAEA is drawn from assessment institutions, individuals and other stakeholders around the world.





1.5 AEAA provides an annual forum held in different member states in Africa on rotational basis, where educational assessment bodies worldwide come together to benchmark, share knowledge, experiences and consequently adapt best practices in educational assessment.

2.0 PARTICIPANTS

- 2.1 The Ministry of Education in the year 2016 in conjunction with the Kenya National Examinations Council initiated critical examination reforms that have drastically enhanced the credibility of our National examinations. This has elevated the status of the Kenyan Education certifications globally and affirms the confidence accorded to Kenya in the education and assessment fields.
- 2.2 In this regard, there is a high expectation from the AEAA members to benchmark with Kenya during the Conference. This forum will also provide an opportunity for universities, other education institutions and professionals in education assessment to conduct research, exchange ideas and get exposed to the global trends in educational assessment.
