CALL FOR PAPERS

The Kenya National Examinations Council (KNEC) will host the 39th Association for Education Assessment in Africa (AEAA) annual conference on 21st to 25th August 2023, in Safari Park Hotel, Nairobi, Kenya. KNEC is honored to invite you to participate and present a paper at the conference.

The Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG 4) aims at ensuring inclusive and equitable quality education and promoting lifelong learning opportunities for all. As we approach the 25th year of the new millennium, the achievement of the SDG 4 goal is still a global concern as several assessment bodies have not incorporated fair assessment that reflects the needs of diverse group of learners. The teaching professional also is slow in restructuring and empowering teachers with the best teaching approaches for inclusive learning that will create the best learning environment that is accessible for all students.

The abstract, not exceeding 350 words, should consider the following format:

a) Author(s) (Name, Organization & email for each one)

b) Title

c) Subtheme

d) Abstract

e) Keywords

Once the notification of acceptance of the abstract has been received, authors will be required to submit the full paper and presentation in the following format:

a) Name of the main presenter (please note you can only be the main presenter for one paper during the conference)

b) Font type: Times New Roman 12

c) Line spacing: 1.5

d) APA References

The abstracts and papers should be submitted to aeaa2023@knec.ac.ke and upload to <https://www.aeaafrica.org> in adherence to the timelines.
