

Excursion sites

Livingstone is Zambia's tourist Capital and it is located on the south-western part of Zambia, a few kilometers from the Zambezi River and the border with Zimbabwe. It's a hub for visitors to the Victoria Falls; the adjoining Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park which surrounds the Zambian side of the falls and the Livingstone Museum which traces local history and archaeology, and the life of the Scottish explorer, David Livingstone, after whom the town was named.

For the steam engine enthusiasts, the Railway Museum in Chishimba Falls Road holds some fine examples of Zambia's railway heritage including old steam locomotives and vintage coaches to the tiniest railway memorabilia and old photographs illustrating life in the pioneer days of the town. Zambezi sunsets are stunning and a boat cruise on the upper Zambezi is a must on any trip to Livingstone.

There are many options from breakfast, lunch or sunset cruises, more social "booze cruises" to more luxurious, relaxed experiences. These boats will take you past the Mosi-oa-tunya National Park where you glimpse hippos, crocodiles, elephants, giraffes and more while sipping on a Gin and Tonic. Introduction

The Examinations Council of Zambia (ECZ) is a corporate body established in 1983 by an Act of Parliament Chapter 137 of the Laws of Zambia with a mandate to conduct Examinations. Further, the ECZ is a Primary member of the Association of Educational Assessment in Africa (AEAA). The Council will be hosting the 38th Association for Educational Assessment in Africa Conference in 2022. This is the fourth time Zambia will be hosting the conference. The first was held in 1990; second in 1999 and the third one in 2014. The Conference is scheduled to take place at AVAN Hotel in Livingstone from 21st to 26th August, 2022. It is expected that the conference will attract over three hundred delegates (300) both local and International.

Getting to Livingstone

Livingstone is very accessible both by road and by air. Daily flights are offered on British Airways (BA) out of Johannesburg to Livingstone, Kenya Airways from Nairobi (good connection for the East, West African countries and Middle East - Asia), South African Airways out of Johannesburg, Proflight and new Zambia Airways (ZN) from Lusaka for those that may come by Emirates and KLM into Lusaka. By road, Livingstone can be approached from four directions, Zimbabwe, Botswana, Namibia and Lusaka. Livingstone is 472km from Lusaka.

Climate

The weather in Livingstone is normally dry, warm to hot by day and cool in the evenings. The average high temperature in August is 29.5°C while lowest is 14.1°C.
